**“Charity” defined:**

Greek word: ὁ*Agape*ῶ  
ὁ*Affection*, good will, love, benevolenceῶ  
ὁ*Love as God loves*ῶ

(John 3:16) (Romans 5:8) (1<sup>st</sup> John 3:16)

(1<sup>st</sup> John 4:7-8) (Romans 13:10)

**According to 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 13...**

***Charity is Preeminent***

(1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 13:1-3)

There is nothing more valuable.

***Charity is Prolific***

(1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 13:4-7)

The root and fruit of every virtue.

***Charity is Predominant***

(1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 13:8-13)
