Sermon Title: *From Slave to Son*Sermon Text: Philemon 1-25

(Philemon 1-25)

The Characters...

Philemon:

A well-do-to convert to Christianity; The church at Colosse met in his home.

Onesimus:

A thieving, runaway slave of Philemon; The Apostle Paul led him to Christ.

Paul:

The author of this letter to Philemon;

The mediator between Philemon and Onesimus.

(Philemon 15)

Observation #1:

Onesimus' sin had led him to flee to Rome, where he had providentially become a believer.

(Philemon 15)

Observation #2:

Paul wanted Philemon to accept Onesimus back as a "beloved brother" instead of a slave.

(Philemon 17)

Observation #3:

Paul's appeal was based on his relationship to Philemon, NOT on Onesimus' worth or innocence.

(Philemon 12) (Philemon 18)

Observation #4:

Paul knew that restitution was important, and volunteered to pay whatever Onesimus owed.

(Philemon 19) (Philemon 11, 13)

Observation #5:

Paul understood that the new Onesimus would be profitable to both he and Philemon.
