Subjected to Injustice "Taken from prison and from judgment" Surrounded by Indifference "Who shall declare His generation?" Slaughtered in Innocence "He was cut off... He was stricken" (1st Corinthians 15:3) (Isaiah 53:9)

Died with the Wicked Buried with the Wealthy
