On the Probability of the Accounts... Do they agree with the evidence?

Homer's Iliad – 1800 Demosthenes – 400 Tacitus – 20 Julius Caesar – 10 Pliny – 7 **Greek New Testament – 5,824**

"The average classical Greek writer has less than 20 copies of his works still in existence. Stack them up, and they're 4 feet high. If you stack up the copes of the New Testament manuscripts, they would be over a mile high."
