Three possible reasons Jesus "hid" Himself...

- #1 The ministry of the eternal Word was more important than temporary miracles. (Romans 10:17)
- #2 Completion of the Father's will is more important than our understanding of it. (John 12:16, 13:7, 16:12)
- #3 God's sovereign working for our good doesn't require our advice or consent. (Matthew 16:22) (Romans 9:20-21)

What is more important for us than understanding God's Mysterious Ways?

- Knowing and trusting His Word.
- Praying for and seeking His will.
- Finding rest and peace in who He is.
