Desire to work

Desire to excel

Desire to help

Sinful – Unduly high opinion of oneself.

Sense of entitlement

Sense of superiority

Sense of self-infatuation

Pride... Described

Self-Centeredness

(Proverbs 13:10, 28:25)

Self-Glorifying

(Proverbs 27:2)

Self-Righteousness

(Proverbs 26:12)

Pride... Defeated

Only by...

The Virtue of Humility

Humility... Can Be Found...

Not by Our Own Self-Effort

Only by Submission to Christ

(Matthew 18:4) (Proverbs 22:4) (James 4:10) (1st Peter 5:6)

The Vice of Sinful Pride

By Definition...

Is an unduly high opinion of oneself that enthrones self about all others.

By Description...

Is self-centered, self-glorifying, self-righteous, and self-destructive.

Is Defeated...

Only by bowing to the grace, knowledge, and Lordship of Christ.

Is everything that sinful pride is not!
Is a wonderful master and servant!
Is only found by knowing & following Christ!
