Where They Came From

(Matthew 25:41) (Revelation 12:7-9)

Satan is the commander and chief of the demonic army.

(Ezekiel 28:12-19)

His origin was as a created, anointed angel in Heaven.

(Isaiah 14:12-15)

He was likely once the "chief of angels"

He was ruined by the "I will" of foolish pride.

(Ezekiel 28:16) (Revelation 12:9)

He was "cast out" of Heaven into the earth.

(Revelation 12:4, 12:8)

He led one-third of Heaven's angels to rebel with him.

(2nd Peter 2:4) (Jude 6)

Who They Are

Satan and his demonic army are...

Invisible, evil, powerful spirits, enemies of God and man.

Innumerable, organized, full of wrath, with limited time.

Unredeemable: no salvation is offered to them, only judgment.

(1st Peter 5:8)

Working desperately and deceptively against man's redemption.

Working to transform man into their proud, rebellious image.

(John 8:44)

Who Do You Resemble?

Are your words, thoughts, and deeds Christ-like?

Or, is there a demonic power influencing sinful rebellion?

(Romans 6:16)

Man's redemption can be defined by five "I wills".

#1: *I will bow myself in utter humility before my God.*

#2: *I will admit that I am a sinner in need of His mercy.*

#3: *I will declare that Jesus died and rose again for me.*

#4: *I will trust His cleansing blood alone for salvation.*

#5: *I will yield my life to Christ as my Savior and King.*

(1st John 1:9)
