<u>Jesus is...</u>

The Angel of the Lord (John 1:14) *The Promise of God* (Genesis 22:18, 12:3, 18:18, 26:4, 28:14) (Galatians 3:8, 3:16) (Acts 3:25-26)

The Isaac of God

Parallels between Isaac and Christ: Sons of promise Births announced by angels Named before conception Miraculous conceptions "Only begotten son"

(Hebrews 11:17) (John 3:16)

Led to the mountain of sacrifice Carried the wood of sacrifice Sin offerings Laid down willingly Dead three days (figuratively/literally) (Genesis 22:4) Rose third day (figuratively/literally) (Hebrews 11:19) Received all their father's inheritance (Genesis 25:5) (Matthew 11:27, 28:18)

The Lamb the Lord Provided (Genesis 22:7-8)

Three applications from this Bible story...

- 1st *We all have our Isaacs.* (Matthew 16:24-26) (*Insert chorus of song printed below*)

- 3rd When we recognize and respond in faith to those two truths, God will use our own lives to be a portrait of His mercy and grace in the midst of a sinful and dying world.
