Sermon Text: **Mark 4:35-41**

(**Mark 4:35-41**)

Observation #1:

“Jesus will pause a ministry to multitudes to meet a pressing need of one desperate man.”

(**Luke 15:4, 15:7**)

Observation #2:

“Traveling with Jesus guarantees that storms will gather against you in this world.”

(**2nd Timothy 3:12**)

Observation #3:

“Even those not with Jesus can benefit from the intercessions of those who are.”

Observation #4:

“Jesus has never been in a storm that was capable of overthrowing His sovereign purpose.”

(**Colossians 2:15**)

Observation #5:

“The deficiency of our faith does not diminish the power of Jesus over any storm.”

(**Matthew 13:58**) (**Mark 6:5**) (**James 1:6-8**)

Observation #6:

“Sometimes the storms are allowed to simply showcase the sovereignty of our Savior.”

Main Point:

“The divine compassion of Christ hears the desperate pleas of people who cry out to Him.”
