(Exodus 34:5-8)

Is God Holy, or Is God Loving?

God Is Holy: *separate; distinct; perfect; pure.*

(1st Peter 1:16) (Exodus 15:11) (Psalm 99:9)

Flowing from God's holiness is...

His truth, righteousness, justice, judgment, wrath;

Our response of awe and fear.

(Revelation 15:4) (Isaiah 6:3) (Habakkuk 1:13)

God Is Love: *affection; devotion; concern; regard.*

(1st John 4:8) (Jeremiah 31:3) (John 3:16)

Flowing from God's love is...

His mercy, grace, patience, forgiveness, goodness;

Our response of faith and devotion.

(Ephesians 2:4-5) (1st John 4:19) (1st John 5:3)

God Is Holy, God Is Love!

(Psalm 85:10) (Isaiah 45:21) (Micah 7:18)

(John 1:14) (Romans 3:26)

The best expression of God's Holy Love...

Is in the Cross of the Lord Jesus Christ!
