Laodicea: Christian Externally, But Christless Internally

"The Faithful & True Witness" - Revealer

"The Beginning of the Creation" - Creator

Jesus' Unveiling of the Laodicean Church

Sickeningly Lukewarm

"Cold" - Spiritually Lifeless

"Hot" – Spiritually Fervent

"Lukewarm" – Spiritually Indifferent

Seriously Self-Deceived

What they thought: "Rich, happy, satisfied." What Jesus knew: "Poor, blind, naked."
